## Guidelines for Presenters

- Presenters are required to submit their presentations in advance by 8 April, 2026.
- Presenters are requested to be present in the session room prior to the start of technical sessions by 9 am on 10 April, 2026 to ensure smooth technical setup.
- Each presenter will be allocated 8 minutes for presentation, followed by 2 minutes for discussion.
- A time notification will be provided by the Session Chair:
  - At **6 minutes** – to signal nearing conclusion
  - At **8 minutes** – to indicate closure

emphasis should be placed on key messages, main arguments, findings and contributions rather than detailed descriptions.

- It is recommended to carry a backup copy of the presentation.
- Engage with the audience while maintaining professional decorum

### Structure of the Presentation

- Introduction and Context
- Objectives / Research Questions
- Methodology / Approach
- Key Findings / Insights
- Conclusion and Policy/Practice Implications

### Presentation Materials

- Presenters are advised to prepare concise slide presentations (5–8 slides).
- Slides should be clear, readable, and visually structured, avoiding excessive text.
- Use of figures, tables, and bullet points is encouraged to enhance clarity.

### Session Management

- The Session Chair will moderate the discussion. Presenters are requested to respond concisely and directly to questions within the allotted time.
- The Session Chair will ensure effective time management. Presentations exceeding the allocated time may be intervened to maintain the overall schedule.
